

THE SUSPENDING OF MILITARY OPERATIONS ON THE ROMANIAN FRONT. THE TRUCE WITH CENTRAL POWERS

SUMMARY

The study presents the inward and international circumstances in which the truce with the Central Powers was signed, emphasizing that it was dictated by inauspicious external causes as a result of Russia sally from war, after the Great Socialist Revolution victory in October.

The author presents next the terms and the way in which the truce was concluded. He introduces also the political and military consequences of this achievement, and the fact, that in spite of its difficult terms, the truce had been the only realistic solution, because Romania, isolated and without any support from its occidental allies, as it was then, was unable to continue the fight.

Meanwhile it is presented the political leaders attitude faced with the truce achievement in 1917, November the 26th/December the 9th. There are submitted in the same time, the opinions of other Romanians, from abroad, faced with the cease fire on the Romanian front, emphasizing the fact the struggle for the national unity would be continued beyond the country frontiers by their activity.
