

CONTRIBUTIONS CONCERNING THE VIENNESE ECHO OF THE REVOLUTIONARY EVENTS FROM WALLACHIA IN 1848

SUMMARY

The viennese press, especially that radical, occupied itself at length of the revolutionary movements from 1848 from Wallachia. All materials result from liking and solidarity with the romanian people. More papers like *Der Volksfreund*, *Wiener Schnellpost*, a.s.o. reported that the revolution won without bloodshed. Also, more papers analysed the programme of the revolution and related about the firmness of the Romanian people who knew to defend the revolution against two counterrevolutionary blows. The radical viennese press looked with sympathy the wish of all romanian people to unite into an unitary and democratical state. Thus, the most revealing articles were those published in *Der Freimütige* and *Der Volksfreund*. The viennese paper like *Der Radikaler*, *Gerad'aus*, a.s.o. informed at length of the great reactionary powers manoeuvres. *Die Presse*, *Wiener Zeitung*, a.s.o. gave a wide space to the resistance offered by the romanians against the interventionist ottomans, who defeated the revolution.
