

NEW FUNERARY DISCOVERIES BELONGING TO THE WIETENBERG CULTURE

SUMMARY

The paper presents new Bronze Age graves recently discovered in the Alba county: one cremation grave from Cetea, another from Uioara de Jos three from Oiejdea and one burial grave from Micești. All of them were placed in the territory of some Wietenberg settlements. The graves from Micești and Cetea are probably dating from the IInd phase, while the others from Oiejdea and Uioara de Jos belong to the IIIrd phase of the Wietenberg culture.
