SUMMARY

Beginning with the informations of numismatic value availables in *Arhivele pentru filologia și istoria* magazine (1867—1872), the author of the paper studies Timotei Cipariu cares for numismatics.

The informations gave by the great scholar are classified as follows: donations coins being in posesion of the Blaj gymnasium, museum; monetary discoveries in Transylvania, Hungary and Romania; presentation of some numismatic collections.
