

## THE RELATIONS BETWEEN DACIA AND MOESIA SUPERIOR DURING TRAJAN'S REIGN

### (ABSTRACT)

The presence of the 14 troupes from Moesia Superior which 106 A.D. after the conquest of Dacia remained in the province influenced the development of these areas. The troupe units were placed in the Northern Dacia and the South-Western part of it in the following places: Bologa, Românași, Romita, Porolissum, Cășei, Ilișua, Orheiul Bistriței, Călugăreni, Bumbăști, Drobeta, Pojejena, Banatska Palanka.

The analysis of different categories of artefacts (ceramics, adornments), or the religious cults allowed to conclude that the area situated between Dacia and Moesia Superior was in fact an area of common experiences and development.

Based on the same local fond of the Dacians and that of Moesia a common evolution of the Romanisation process was established.
