

## THE COMMUNAL AND COUNTY ELECTION IN FEBRUARY 1926

### (SUMMARY)

Historian that studied the interwar election system focused more on parliamentary elections and less on the local ones. That is why in this study the authors concerns with the first communal and county elections organized in Romania under the basis of universal vote. This study analyses the political conditions in which these elections took place and the legislation on which bases the elections were organized, the electoral cartels formed by the political groups, which participated in the electoral campaign. A great part of the study tales about the political speech asserted not only by the opozition but also by the governing party stressing its main features. The same time, an important part of this article tales about the liberal governs actions and abuses meant to bring this victory in communal and county elections. This study ends by stating the results of the elections. Even if the results were contradictory, they proved the victory of the opozition, of the electoral alliance: The National Party – The Peasants' Party – The People's Party
