

STAMPED BRICKS FROM FEHÉR'S COLLECTION

ABSTRACT

The collection includes 14 kinds of stamps printed on rectangular bricks of the same type. Half of them are simple, with the legion's name in abbreviate form: G, GE, and GEM. At the other half, the anthroponyms cannot be completed because of the laconic abbreviation. On a stamp, the abbreviation of the legion's name is missing. The structure of stamps is very similar to that identified on some bricks from Vindobona. The using of the same *instrumentum* (negative-stamp) on bricks founded in these two consecutive residences of the XIIIth Gemina legion indicates the activity of the same brick-makers both at Vindobona and Apulum, at the very beginning of the Carpathian province.
