

A NEW DISCOVERED BRONZE BYZANTIN COIN FROM THE AIUD AREA

(SUMMARY)

In 1995, near Ciumbrud (from the Aiud municipium) has been discovered a bronze *follies*, an emission of Tiberios II Constantinos, from 581/582.

Besides, there are presented some almost new coin, included in a numismatic inventory written in hunderish, from 1891/93.

It is supposed that the *follies* of Tiberios II as well as the other coins belonging to the Western Roman Imperium, the Eastern Roman Imperium and the Byzantin Imperium (including the Nicaea Imperium) had arrived here through the connections between the local roman or migratory population and the late roman or byzantin world.
