

**DOCUMENTS CONCERNING THE ADHESION OF THE ROMANIANS FROM  
THE FĂGĂRAȘ REGION TO THE MEMORANDIST MOVEMENT  
(1892—1894)**

**SUMMARY**

The paper sets off various aspects connected with the struggle of the people from the Făgăraș region for the triumph of the national cause during the extremely agitated period of the memorandist movement (1892—1894).

The authors describe the evolution of the socio-economic, cultural and national existence of the inhabitants of this part of Transylvania at a time when, the national exploitation of the Romanians was intensified after the austro-hungarian dualism. At the same time, moments of the radicalization and organization of the national movement at the end of the XIX<sup>th</sup> century are depicted.

On the ground of unpublished documents especially those conserved in the collection of the Museum of the Union from Alba Iulia, of the national press accounts, the authors render the various stages of the participation of some of the leaders of the national life in the Făgăraș region to the memorandist movement, as well as the wide adhesion of the village dwellers from this territory to the *Memorandum* and their solidarity with the P.N.R. leaders incriminated in the political process at Cluj in 1894.
