

**THE ENTRANCE OF ROMANIA IN WORLD WAR I ON THE ANTANTA'S SIDE
AND THE ROUMANIANS FROM ABROAD ATTITUDE**

SUMMARY

This study presents, first of all, the internal conditions of the Roumania entrance in World War I on the Antanta's side, emphasizeing the fact that the purpose of our country participation at that conflagration was the improvement of the national unity. The author describes further, the Transylvanians

refugees position facing this event, meanwhile, showing the Roumanians prisoners attitude, from Russia and Italy, former solders in Austria—Hungarian army, eager to give their contribution to this great national ideal. It is presented also, the activity of the Roumanians from USA, Canada and France, helping by all the possible ways the national cause.

Finally it is analysed the defeat of the Roumanian army because of the numerical inferiority and armament, also of the mistakes from the battlefield. But in spite of these, the activity of the Roumanians from abroad didn't stop, continuing on a new stage, as the conclusion of the study points out.
