

**DACIAN ARCHEOLOGICAL VESTIGES AT SÂNGEORGIU DE MUREȘ
(THE MUREȘ DISTRICT)**

SUMMARY

The author presents the Dacian vestiges in a multi-millenary settlement (with evidences from the Age of Bronze and from the early feudal period), placed in the topographical point „Dealul Bunii” (fig. 1), settlement explored summarily by archeological soundings during the years 1987, 1988.

The investigations have revealed from the settlement rich ceramics of common use and fine ones. Out of these, the author presents some reconstituted pots and, in a selective way, fragments of pots (fig. 3/1–6), and also fragments of hand mills (fig. 4/1–10), discovered in the same settlement. The discovered evidences belong to the classical phase of the Dacian culture (the I-st Century b.Ch. — the I-st century a. Ch.), adding a new Dacian settlement, not known before, to the archeological collection of the zone.
