

**THE HOARD OF COINS DISCOVERED AT OCNA MUREŞ  
FROM THE 19<sup>th</sup> AND THE 20<sup>th</sup> CENTURIES**

**SUMMARY**

The hoard was discovered in March 1992 by Dorin Andone in Ocna Mureş city, 17 street Cloşca, in his house-yard with the occasion of excavation.

The hoard is compound by 410 coins, 52 gold coins and 358 silver coins emissions included between 1873-1915 of Empire Francisc Ioseph I.

In spite of all necessary steps, the hoard couldn't enter in the patrimony of U.M.N. Alba Iulia , but with all the difficulties in our investigation and even with some possible lacks, we thought beeing useful to put in to the scientific circulation.

The hoard is compound by pieces of 10 and 20 gold kronens and silver pieces of 1 florin, 2 kronens and 1 kronen Austrians and Hungarians emissions.

We have to mention the fact that 1 florin = 2 kronens according to the Law from 1892, there the hoard had worth 1223 kronens. It contains coins with large nominals, many of them of gold, by comparison to another hoards known from this period in Transylvania.

We think that this hoard had been buried between 1918-1919, when Austro-Hungarian Empire divided up.
