

A NEW SILVER TETRADRACHMA FROM AIUD

SUMMARY

The tetradrachma is an almost exact imitation of the Philip the II-nd type emitted in Pella. It can be dated in about the year 300 before Christ and it can be related both with the existence of the Celtic I cemetery of Aiud and also with some Dacic settlements from the city territory or from the surroundings, dated back in the III-II-nd century before Christ.

With this coin the number of the discovered coins in the zone of Aiud reaches twelve.
