

## ABOUT SURGUCI IN THE XVI<sup>th</sup> AND XVII<sup>th</sup> CENTURY

### - SUMMARY -

*Surguci* was an aigrette by the voievodes of the Wallachia and Moldavia on the fur cup.

The name *surguci* taken over from the ottomans although it was a piece complete different of the turban ornament was specified in Rumanian language in two chronicles from the second half of the XVII<sup>th</sup> century.

We were trying to prove that this piece of adornment was known from the second half of the XVI<sup>th</sup> century and in the end we were bringing out an unknown piece of the kind from the same period possessed by the National Museum of History.
