

**A DISCOVERY BELONGING TO THE COȚOFENI CULTURE
AT LIMBA - *IN COASTĂ* (ALBA DISTRICT)**

(SUMMARY)

In 1997 campaign, the sistematical archaeological researches from Limba site, have been extended, having in view especially the marginal parts of the area, in wich there found prehistorical settlements belonging to the neolithic age.

In the point *În Coastă*, in the section ($S_1/1997$) carried out on a higher, marginal of terras, was discovered a complex belonging to the Coțofeni Culture.

The tipological-stylistic analysis of the archaeological material (especially the pottery) proved that this complex belongs to the phase II of this culture (Coțofeni).
