

BIHOREAN'S PREPARATION FOR THE GREAT NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FROM ALBA IULIA

(SUMMARY)

Bihorean romanians started preparations for the Grand National Assembly from Alba Iulia immediately after, at 20 November 1918, National Romanian Central Council in Arad launched appeal to the Romanian people in order to take part at the glorious act.

Bihor's delegates popular assemblies of election were unfolded in period 24-27 november 1918, under direct guidance and leadership of the National Romanian Council from Oradea, whos president was Aurel Lazăr.

At Alba Iulia, bihorean romanians were represented by selected delegates, about whom went of personal initiative, numerous romanian peasants and intellectulals from Oradiei, Beiuşului and Vascăului regions.
