

THE HISTORICAL MUSEUM OF AIUD IN DOCUMENTARY AND BIBLIOGRAPHICAL TESTIMONIES (II) THE ACTIVITY OF THE MUSEUM IN MANUSCRIPTS BELONGING TO THE END OF THE XIXth CENTURY AND THE BEGINNING OF THE XXth CENTURY

(SUMMARY)

1. Informations and reports concerning archaeological resurch and the enrichment of the collection.

There are presented the manuscripts of five informings and reports concerning the activity between 1899 and 1904.

2. Two correspondances about the collaboration between the Museum of the Collegium of Aiud and the Transylvanian Museum of Cluj.

- a) It is presented a letter from 1888 signed by Herepei Karoly, the custodian of the Museum of Aiud to the Director Posta Bela of the Museum of Cluj.

It is about the archaeological diggings in the Livezile tumulus with the financial support of the Transylvanian Museum of Cluj, and about the sending of the resulted material.

In the annex there is presentad a report about the expences ant the sum of money which was left.

- b) A postcard from 1905 signed by dr. Szilády Zoltán to the Director of the Transylvanian Museum about the beginning of the some diggings in the Apuseni Mountains (Câmpeni).
