

**A COMPARATIVE STUDY CONCERNING THE FEATURES OF
SOME MANUALLY PRODUCED PAPER TYPES**

(SUMMARY)

Depending on the fibres nature from which they are made of, the paper has a certain level of lastingness in time. The technologies and the complementary materials used while the technological process influence the quality and the lastingness of the paper.

The analyses made on two different types of manually produced paper from XVII century, paper made from linen and hempen fibres, show that these different paper has each one also a different behavior given degradation agents from the environment.

Given the paper made from wood-paste, inferiors to those made from lin and hemp, the ancient manually produced paper from XVII century are much more resistant in time.
